

2010 POWER SMART MANITOBA WINTER GAMES

TECHNICAL PACKAGE

SPORT: BADMINTON

AGE CATEGORY

Youth Male & Female: 18 years of age or younger (born 1992 or later).

Junior Male & Female: 14 years of age or younger (born 1996 or later).

ELIGIBILITY

Participants must meet eligibility rules as outlined in the [General Rules of the 2010 Power Smart Manitoba Games](#)

TEAM COMPOSITION

Participants will compete in one event only.

*One head coach, one assistant coach, one manager (must include at least one male/one female).

COMPETITION RULES

Rules of the Manitoba Badminton Association Inc/Badminton Canada shall apply. All mixed doubles, doubles and men's singles matches will be best two of three games (each game to 21 points).

An athlete can participate in 1 event only. An athlete also can not change events during the Manitoba Winter Games.

Tie Break

1. If two athletes have won the same number of matches then ranking will be decided by the result of the match between them.
2. If three or more athletes have won the same number of matches then the net total of games won and lost in the matches played the athletes involved. If two are still tied then the result between the two will decide the ranking.
3. If three or more athletes are still tied then the net total of games won and lost in all the matches played by the athletes will determine the order. If two are still tied then the result between the two will be the deciding factor.
4. If the tie still exists then the net total of points won and lost in all matches played will be the deciding factor. If two athletes are still tied then the result between the two will be the deciding factor.

5. A conceded match shall count as a loss without the conceding side scoring another point.
6. All results of any athletes that has been disqualified or withdraws shall be entirely deleted.

Note: Depending on the circumstance and timing of disqualification or withdrawal the Referee may choose to overrule #6

EQUIPMENT

Shuttles: Nylon shuttles (Yonex Mavis 350 Yellow – blue speed)

Uniforms: At least 75% of the visible area must be white or regional uniform.

COMPETITIVE UNIFORM

Participants must wear the uniforms provided by Sport Manitoba and the Manitoba Games Council in their competition. Note: more information to follow.

OFFICIALS

The Manitoba Badminton Association shall approve all officials.

All matches will be played in Southport Gymnasium.

PROVINCIAL TECHNICAL ADVISOR ROLES AND RESPONSIBILITIES

1. Provide sport technical knowledge to all aspects of the Manitoba Games.
2. Assist in the development and understanding of the 2010 Power Smart Manitoba Winter Games Sport Technical Package and sport schedules.
3. Meet with all Games partners as required.
4. Work with Sport Manitoba Regional staff and the Provincial Host Committee Sport Chairs to ensure successful competitions (i.e. officials, facilities etc.) at the regional and provincial level.
5. Conduct or facilitate athlete, coach and officials development clinics.
6. Be available to attend regional qualifying or team selection events, attend the Provincial Finals, participate in the coaches meeting prior to the final competition and act as the chairperson of the Sport Appeal Committee at the Provincial Finals.
7. Provide a written evaluation following the Provincial Finals.

MEDALS

Gold, silver and bronze medals will be awarded to the first, second and third place finishers, respectively.
